- Even if you applied for a certificate in May 2025 or earlier, a certificate will not be issued unless you complete the application in the above-mentioned period. If you wish to complete the program by March 2026, please make sure you complete all the necessary procedures during this period.
- Please make sure to apply only for the programs you are expected to complete.
- Please note that even if you make an application, if you do not satisfy all the requirements to complete the program or you fail to graduate or complete the graduate school, a certificate will not be issued.
